



## Wealthwood Rod & Gun Club League Rules

### All League Rules

- On score sheets please enter team name, full name, and week that you are shooting.
- All scores are to be recorded on the teams posted season scoresheet inside the club house. Scores will be posted each week online at gun club website with handicaps calculated.
- **NO ALCOHOL** on the ranges, beverages can be consumed at the clubhouse during business hours or in the parking lot after hours.
- The club is 100% volunteer based. Please volunteer to fill the trap/skeet machines when you are done shooting. The process to fill the house is as follows:
  - **Disarm the machine before attempting to enter trap house**
  - Load the machine with clay targets
  - Arm the machine so that it is ready for the next group of shooters.
- Handicap rules will apply as follows.
  - The maximum handicap for a team will be 23 targets per round of 25. Sporting clays will be a maximum of 43 targets per round of 50.
  - For teams with more than the minimum number of shooters the maximum handicap for the team will be subtracted by one for every team member over the minimum.
    - Example: Trap team A has 6 shooters, the maximum handicap for trap team A is 22..
  - Handicap score will be calculated using the rolling average of a shooter's scores starting with week 2. For weeks 1 and 2 the handicap will be the average of both weeks 1 and 2. In week three the handicap from weeks 1 through 3 will be applied to the week 3 score. In week 4 the handicap calculated from weeks 1 through 4 will be applied to the weeks 4 score. That pattern will continue on until the final score of the league.
    - Example 1: Score week 1 = 20, score week 2 = 15, weeks 1 & 2 average = 17.5 rounded to 18, handicap (23-18) = 5, Week 1 score with handicap = 23, week 2 score with handicap = 20
    - Example 2: Score week 1 = 20, score week 2 = 15, score week 3 = 21, weeks 1-3 average = 18.66 rounded to 19, handicap (23-19) = 4, Week 1 score with handicap = 23, week 2 score with handicap = 20, week 3 score with handicap = 23
  - Shootoff handicaps will be calculated using weeks 1 through 8 scores and applied to all three rounds of the shoot offs.
    - Example: Shooter A has a 21 average on a team with a 23 target maximum handicap. That shooter has a handicap of 2. Shoot off scores are 20, 24, 23. Shoot off scores with handicap will be 22, 24, 23.

### League specific rules

#### Trap League

- 1) Shoot from 16 yards; Minimum of 5 shooters per team, no maximum, using the five highest scores per week adjusted for handicap.
- 2) All Sponsor fees are due before the first round is shot. This is the Team Captains' responsibility.
- 3) Official scoring to utilize the official score sheets. Practice scoring to be on practice sheets.
- 4) Season will be 8 weeks, 25 birds per week and 2 weeks to shoot one 75 bird shoot off, 25 birds per field.
- 5) After week 4 (100 targets) the league will be split into classes - AA, A, B, etc. The number of classes will be decided based on the number of teams participating in the league.
- 6) ATA rules apply where otherwise not explicitly stated



### **Skeet League**

- 1) Minimum of 3 shooters per team, no maximum, using the 3 highest scores per week adjusted for handicap.
- 2) All Sponsor fees are due before the first round is shot. This is the Team Captains' responsibility.
- 3) Official scoring to utilize the official score sheets. Practice scoring to be on practice sheets.
- 4) Season will be 8 weeks, 25 birds per week and 2 weeks to shoot one 75 bird shoot off.
- 5) After week 4 (100 targets) the league will be split into classes - AA, A, B, etc. The number of classes will be decided based on the number of teams participating in the league.
- 6) NSSA rules apply where otherwise not explicitly stated

### **Sporting Clays League**

- 1) Minimum of 3 shooters per team, no maximum, using the 3 highest scores per week adjusted for handicap.
- 2) All Sponsor fees are due before the 1st round is shot. This is the Team Captains' responsibility.
- 3) Official scoring to utilize the official score sheets. Practice scoring to be on practice sheets.
- 4) NSCA rules apply where otherwise not explicitly stated
- 5) Season will be 4 months and a team must shoot 250 targets on the blue Course and 250 Targets on the Red course. Example schedule for a team
  - a) 50 Targets Blue Course and 50 targets Red Course in month 1
  - b) 100 Targets Blue Course and 100 targets Red Course in month 2
  - c) 50 Targets Blue Course and 50 targets Red Course in month 3
  - d) 50 Targets Blue Course and 50 targets Red Course in month 4

The courses will change monthly at the beginning of the month.

### **Combo League**

- 1) Minimum of 3 shooters per team, no maximum, using the 3 highest scores per week adjusted for handicap.
- 2) All Sponsor fees are due before the first round is shot. This is the Team Captains' responsibility.
- 3) Official scoring to utilize the official score sheets. Practice scoring to be on practice sheets.
- 4) Season will be 4 months and a team must shoot:
  - e) 1 - 25 Trap, 25 Skeet, 25 Sporting Clays at front 5 stations for each month
- 5) After month 2 (150 targets) the league will be split into classes - AA, A, B, etc. The number of classes will be decided based on the number of teams participating in the league.
- 6) ATA, NSSA, and NSCA rules apply where otherwise not explicitly stated
